Mr. Speaker,

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 414**, RAW MILK AMENDMENTS, by Representative C. K. Acton, with the following amendments:

1. *Page Line 64 through 68:*

- 64 (g) the bacterial count of the raw milk used to produce the raw milk product does  
not  
65 exceed 20,000 colony forming units per milliliter and, if the bacterial count of the  
raw milk used to produce the raw milk product exceeds 40,000 colony forming units  
per milliliter or the producer is implicated in a foodborne illness outbreak, the raw  
milk shall be tested and may not contain the following pathogens:
- (i) STEC;
  - (ii) e.coli 0157:H7;
  - (iii) listeria;
  - (iv) salmonella; and
  - (v) campylobacter ;
- 66 (h) the coliform count of the raw milk used to produce the raw milk product does  
not  
67 exceed 10 colony forming units per milliliter and, if the coliform count of the raw  
milk used to produce the raw milk product exceeds 20 colony forming units per  
milliliter or the producer is implicated in a foodborne illness outbreak, the raw milk  
shall be tested and may not contain the following pathogens:
- (i) STEC;
  - (ii) e.coli 0157:H7;
  - (iii) listeria;
  - (iv) salmonella; and
