Mr. Speaker,

The Business, Labor, and Commerce Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 495**, HEALTH CARE AMENDMENTS, by Representative J. A. Dunnigan, with the following amendments, and recommends it be placed on the Consent Calendar:

- 1. Page Line 208 through 209:
  - 208 credit card or other similar arrangement.
  - 209 (d)An insurer shall { accept } allow a tangible check as a form of acceptable payment.
- 2. Page Line 240 through 242:
  - 240 (a) based on the provider's contracted fee for covered services, uses downcoding in a
  - 241 manner that prevents a dental provider from collecting the <u>contracted</u> fee for the actual service
  - 242 performed from either the plan or the patient; [or]
- 3. Page Line 245 through 250:
  - a procedure that may be provided in conjunction with another procedure[-];
  - 246 (c)does not allow a dental provider to {bill} seek payment of the contracted fee for a covered service from the patient {for a service} when the insurer
  - 247 <u>denies</u> { <u>the claim</u> } <u>payment</u> <u>for the service, unless under generally accepted</u> practice standards,
  - 248 the service performed should not be billed; or







- 249 (d) <u>beginning January 1, 2026,</u> <u>automatically recoups an overpayment unless:</u>
- 250 (i)the recoupment occurs more than 60 days from the day the insurer sends a notice
