Mr. Speaker,

The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. S.B. 170**, SCHOOL DISCIPLINE AMENDMENTS, by Senator L. Escamilla, with the following amendments, and, due to fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee for prioritization.

- 1. Page Line 257 through 259:
 - 257 (B)alternative interventions used;
 - 258 (C)student demographic information , including sex, age, grade in school, and applicable disability status ; and
 - (D)incident outcomes.
- 2. *Page Line 311 through 313:*
 - 311 (v)the use is time-limited and monitored; and
 - 312 (c)shall notify parents { in a reasonable amount time } immediately { not to exceed 24 hours } of:
 - 313 (i)any emergency safety intervention used on the parent's child, including seclusion
- 3. Page Line 322 through 324:







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- 322 (iii)alternative interventions attempted;
- 323 <u>(iv)student demographic information</u> <u>, including sex, age, grade in school, and applicable disability status</u> ; and
- 324 (v)relevant training offered to staff and if the staff involved received the relevant
