Mr. President,

The Economic Development and Workforce Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 189**, CHILD CARE SERVICES AMENDMENTS, by Senator L. Escamilla, with the following amendments:

- 1. Line 108:
 - 108 more than one licensed child care program.

(4) (a) Upon identifying a property described in Subsections (1)(a) through (c), the Division of Facilities Construction and Management shall conduct a study of potential market impacts of an expanded child care opportunity facility on private child care centers in the surrounding area.

(b) The Division of Facilities and Construction Management and the office shall take into consideration the impact study described in Subsection (4)(a) before retrofitting or building an expanded child care facility described under this part.

- 2. Line 136 through 142:
 - 136 (d) the employer sponsor to maintain general liability and workers compensation
 - 137 insurance in minimum amounts established by the Division of {Facilities Construction}
 - 138 {and Management} Risk Management by rule;
 - 139 (e) the employer sponsor to require a contracted licensed provider to maintain general
 - 140 liability and workers' compensation **insurance** in minimum amounts established by the Division
 - 141 of {Facilities Construction and Management} Risk Management by rule;
 - 142 (f) that the employer sponsor reserve no more than 60% of capacity limit of the leased
