Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **S.B. 240**, CONGREGATE CARE MODIFICATIONS, by Senator D. R. Owens, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. S.B. 240**, CONGREGATE CARE MODIFICATIONS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 22 through 24:
 - 22 →provide notice to a congregate care program; or
 23 →remove restrictions { and conditions } on new admissions or a conditional license { on a congregate care program's license } ; and
 24 →makes technical changes.
- 2. Page Line 542 through 544:
 - 542 (b)The department may not restrict or prohibit new admissions at a congregate care
 - 543 program based on the sole fact that the congregate care program is operating under a
 - 544 <u>conditional license.</u>
- 3. Page Line 608 through 613:
 - 608

(ii)may remove a restriction or prohibition on new admissions at a congregate care







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- 609 program if {<u>the office</u>} :
- 610 (A) <u>the office</u> conducts two consecutive inspections showing full compliance with the
- 611 violated rules and any corrective action required by the office;
- 612 (B) <u>the office</u> finds no new violations upon which the office may place a restriction or
- 613 prohibition on new admissions; and
- 4. Page Line 616 through 618:
 - 616 (iii)shall remove a conditional license on a congregate care program if:
 - 617 (A)the {congregate care } program has rectified all issues for which the conditional
 - 618 <u>license was initially imposed;</u>
