Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee recommends **S.B. 240**, CONGREGATE CARE MODIFICATIONS, by Senator D. R. Owens, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **2nd Sub. S.B. 240**, CONGREGATE CARE MODIFICATIONS with the following amendments:

1. *Page Line 22 through 24:*

- 22 →provide notice to a congregate care program; or  
23 →remove restrictions {~~and conditions~~} on new admissions or a  
conditional license {~~on a congregate care program's license~~} ; and  
24 →makes technical changes.

2. *Page Line 542 through 544:*

- 542 (b)The department may not restrict or prohibit new admissions at a congregate care  
543 program based on **the** sole fact that the congregate care program is operating under a  
544 conditional license.

3. *Page Line 608 through 613:*

- 608 (ii)may remove a restriction or prohibition on new admissions at a congregate care
