Mr. Speaker,

The Transportation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 251**, COMMERCIAL VEHICLE REGISTRATION AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. L. Ipson, with the following amendments, and, due to fiscal impact, recommends it be referred to the Rules Committee for prioritization.

- 1. Page Line 52 through 55:
 - 52 transferred without first obtaining a Utah title.
 - 53 { (4)A vehicle with a conditional registration under this section does not qualify for the }
 - 54 {<u>alternative special registration card and registration decal described in Section</u> 41-1a-232.}
 - (4) If a Utah title is not issued for a vehicle within 10 months of the beginning of the month in which a conditional registration is issued for the vehicle, the division shall:
 - (a) revoke the conditional registration for the vehicle; and
 - (b) not allow the vehicle to be registered in the state until a Utah title is obtained for the vehicle.
 - 55 (5)A commercial vehicle that is issued a conditional registration as provided in this section
- 2. Page Line 59:
 - 59 division.
 - (7) A conditional registration under this section may not be issued to a vehicle subject to apportioned registration under Section 41-1a-301.
