The Education Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 308**, DUAL LANGUAGE IMMERSION AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. McCay, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page Line 31 through 34:
  - 31 student learns, at least in part:
  - 32 (i) through {-online learning with an element of student control over time, place, path,
  - 33 and pace | synchronous online learning ; and
  - 34 (ii) in the physical presence of an instructor.
- 2. Page Line 44 through 46:
  - 44 (B)who demonstrates language proficiency of advanced-high or higher on a
  - 45 <u>verbal and written exam</u> { <u>from a nationally recognized organization</u> <u>used</u>} <u>using nationally recognized standards</u> to
  - 46 assess an instructor's language proficiency; and
- 3. Page Line 49 through 57:
  - 49 (A)holds a master's degree or higher or has at least 18 completed credit hours of
  - 50 graduate course work in an academic field related to the program; and
  - 51 (B)demonstrates language proficiency of advanced-high or higher on a verbal and
  - 52 written exam from a nationally recognized organization used to assess an
  - 53 <u>instructor's language proficiency</u> {; and}







- 54 {<u>(C)has taught an upper division language course at a state university or has</u>

- 55 { previously taught at least three Utah Language Bridge Program courses at a }
- 56 { high school with a university co-teacher. }
- 57 (2) The University of Utah shall partner with all state universities to develop and maintain,
- 4. Page Line 64 through 66:
  - (c) [are delivered]the university delivers:
  - 65 (i) using {-a} an in-person or blended learning delivery model; and
  - (ii) [by an eligible]through a qualified instructor[described in Subsection
- 5. Page Line 75 through 77:
  - 75 (b) If a state university cannot provide a qualified instructor to an LEA in the state
  - 76 university's service area in accordance with Subsection (4)(a), an LEA
