Representative **Andrew Stoddard** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Line 14 through 16:
 - →modifies the term of office for chief justice;
 - →modifies provisions related to an interim chief justice and appointment procedures; {and}
 - → provides that the justices of the Supreme Court elect the president of the Senate and the speaker of the House of Representatives; and
 - →makes technical and conforming changes.
- 2. *Line 28 through 30:*
 - 28 **78A-3-101** Number of justices -- Terms -- Chief justice and associate chief
 - justice -- Selection and functions <u>-- Election of president of the Senate and speaker of the House</u> of Representatives.
 - 30 (1) The Supreme Court consists of five justices.
- *3. Line* 87:
 - 87 served as associate chief justice.
 - (7) Following a general election and before January 1 of odd-numbered years, the justices of the Supreme Court shall elect:
 - (a) a president from among the members of the Senate as the Senate will be constituted based on the results of the general election; and
 - (b) a speaker from among the members of the House of Representatives as the House of Representatives will be constituted based on the results of the general election.
