

Representative **Ryan D. Wilcox** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 278 through 284:*

278 (ii) if the peace officer noted or the department determines that there is reasonable
279 cause to believe that the information given under Subsection (1) is not correct, the
280 department shall contact directly the insurance company or other provider of
281 security as described in Section **{41-12a-303.2} 41-12a-302** and request verification of the
282 accuracy of the information submitted as of the date of the accident.
283 (b) The department may require the verification under Subsection (4)(a)(ii) to be in a
284 form specified by the department.

2. *Line 295 through 302:*

295 (6) In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the
296 department may make rules for the enforcement of this section.
297 (7) A person is guilty of a class B misdemeanor, and shall be fined not less than \$100, who:
298 (a) when requested to provide security information under Subsection (1), or Section
299 **{41-12a-303.2} 41-12a-302**, provides false information;
300 (b) falsely represents to the department that security required under this chapter is in
301 effect; or
302 (c) sells a vehicle to avoid the penalties of this section as applicable either to himself or

3. *Line 489 through 499:*

489 41-12a-402 or 41-12a-403 may not terminate the insurance policy unless notice of
490 termination is filed with the department no later than 10 days after termination as
491 required under Section 41-12a-404.
492 {(d) If an actor who has canceled the certificate of insurance applies for a license within }
493 {three years from the date of proof of owner's or operator's security was originally }
494 {required, the department shall refuse the application unless the person reestablishes }
495 {proof of owner's or operator's security and maintains the proof for the remainder of }
496 {the three-year period.}
497 (d) The department shall:
498 (i) suspend the actors driver license for the remainder of the three-year period if the
499 department is notified that security required in subsection (8)(b) is no longer valid; and

(ii) may not reinstate the actor's driver license or issue a driver license to the actor until the actor gives the department proof of owner's or operator's security for the remainder of the three-year period.

497 (9) A card issued by an insurance company as evidence of owner's or operator's security
498 under Subsection (1)(a)(i)(E) may not display the owner's or operator's address on the
499 card.
