

Representative **Jason E. Thompson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 2668 through 2682:*

2668 **58-91-307** Temporary permits for alarm company agents.

2669 (1) The division may issue a temporary permit to an applicant for licensure as an alarm
2670 company agent if:

2671 (a) **(i) the applicant has resided in this state for at least the 12 months before applying for a**
temporary permit; and

2672 **(ii) the division has received a background check on the applicant from the Bureau of**
Criminal Identification; and

2673 **{(b) (i) the applicant is or will be employed at a call center, office, or administrative }**
{facility of an alarm company; and}

2675 **{(ii) the applicant's only contact with a customer or potential customer of the alarm }**
{company is from the call center, office, or administrative facility; and}

2677 **{(e) (b) the alarm company by which the applicant is or will be employed affirms in writing**
2678 to the division that the applicant will act only within the scope of the temporary
2679 license {, as provided in Subsection (1)(b)} :

2680 (2) A temporary license shall expire on the earlier of:

2681 (a) 90 days after the day on which the division issues the temporary permit;

2682 (b) the date on which the individual to whom the division issues the temporary license
