

Representative **Jason E. Thompson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 2668 through 2682:*

2668        **58-91-307** Temporary permits for alarm company agents.

2669        (1) The division may issue a temporary permit to an applicant for licensure as an alarm

2670        company agent if:

2671        (a) (i) the applicant has resided in this state for at least the 12 months before applying for a  
temporary permit; and

2672        (ii) the division has received a background check on the applicant from the Bureau of  
Criminal Identification; and

2673        {(b) (i) the applicant is or will be employed at a call center, office, or administrative }

2674        { facility of an alarm company; and }

2675        {(ii) the applicant's only contact with a customer or potential customer of the alarm }

2676        { company is from the call center, office, or administrative facility; and }

2677        {(e) (b) the alarm company by which the applicant is or will be employed affirms in writing

2678        to the division that the applicant will act only within the scope of the temporary

2679        license {, as provided in Subsection (1)(b)} .

2680        (2) A temporary license shall expire on the earlier of:

2681        (a) 90 days after the day on which the division issues the temporary permit;

2682        (b) the date on which the individual to whom the division issues the temporary license
