

Representative **Jason E. Thompson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 2709 through 2723:*

2709       **58-91-307** Temporary permits for alarm company agents.

2710       (1) The division may issue a temporary permit to an applicant for licensure as an alarm  
2711       company agent if:

2712       (a) **(i) the applicant has resided in this state for at least the 12 months before applying for a**  
**temporary permit; and**

2713       **(ii) the division has received a background check on the applicant from the Bureau of**  
**Criminal Identification; and**

2714       **{(b) (i) the applicant is or will be employed at a call center, office, or administrative**  
**facility of an alarm company; and}**

2715       **{(ii) the applicant's only contact with a customer or potential customer of the alarm-**  
**company is from the call center, office, or administrative facility; and}**

2716       **{(e) (b) the alarm company by which the applicant is or will be employed affirms in writing**  
2717       to the division that the applicant will act only within the scope of the temporary  
2718       license {, as provided in Subsection (1)(b)} :

2719       (2) A temporary license shall expire on the earlier of:

2720       (a) 90 days after the day on which the division issues the temporary permit;

2721       (b) the date on which the individual to whom the division issues the temporary license
