

Representative **Scott H. Chew** proposes the following amendments:

*1. Line 23 through 30:*

23        (1) As used in this section:

24        (a) "Large pond" means a pond for livestock watering that is larger than a small pond.

25        (b) "Livestock" means a domestic animal raised or kept for profit or personal use.

26        (c) "Small pond" means a pond for livestock watering that has a {surface area equal to or}

27        {less than 900 square feet and a depth equal to or less than five feet} volume equal to or less

28        than two acre feet.

29        (d) "Sub-basin livestock watering claim" means a water right recognized to be used to

30        water livestock from existing surface water sources in a geographically defined

sub-drainage boundary approved by the state engineer.
