7 **General Description:**

8 This bill establishes the Nuclear Energy Regulatory Office within the Division of Waste
9 Management and Radiation Control.

2. *Line 99 through 115:*

99 Section **19-14-103**. is enacted to read:

100 **19-14-103** Nuclear energy regulation -- Rulemaking and fee authority.

101 (1) (a) Subject to authorization by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the division may
102 regulate or license activities related to the nuclear fuel cycle within state jurisdiction.

(b) Chapter 3, Part 3, Placement of High Level Nuclear Waste, does not apply to nuclear fuel cycle activities regulated or licensed by the division under this chapter.

103 (2) In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the
104 board may make rules establishing:

105 (a) requirements and procedures for licensing nuclear fuel cycle activities;

106 (b) standards **and performance objectives** for:

107 (i) **nuclear fuel cycle facility siting;**

(ii) compliance inspections;

108 { **(iii)** **safety requirements;**

109 { **(iv)** **security measures;**

110 { **(v)** **environmental protection measures;**

111 { **(vi)** **emergency preparedness and response; and**

112 { **(vii)** **financial assurance and decommissioning;**

113 (c) procedures for coordinating with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on regulatory
