7 **General Description:**

8 This bill establishes the Nuclear Energy Regulatory Office within the Division of Waste
9 Management and Radiation Control.

2. *Line 99 through 115:*

99 Section **19-14-103.** is enacted to read:

100 **19-14-103** Nuclear energy regulation -- Rulemaking and fee authority.

101 (1) **(a) Subject to authorization by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, the division may regulate or license activities related to the nuclear fuel cycle within state jurisdiction.**

(b) Chapter 3, Part 3, Placement of High Level Nuclear Waste, does not apply to nuclear fuel cycle activities regulated or licensed by the division under this chapter.

103 (2) **In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the board may make rules establishing:**

105 **(a) requirements and procedures for licensing nuclear fuel cycle activities;**

106 **(b) standards and performance objectives for:**

107 **(i) nuclear fuel cycle facility siting;**

(ii) compliance inspections;
