**School Materials Amendments**

Representative **Nicholeen P. Peck** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 226 through 233:*

226 (a) a person brings or incurs as a result of this section; and

227 (b) is not covered by the person's insurance policies or any coverage agreement that the  
228 State Risk Management Fund issues.

229 (11) **(a)** A vendor may not sell or promote goods or services through a digital instructional  
230 material the vendor provides to a contracting entity.

**(b) A vendor that provides digital instructional material to a contracting entity shall certify that the digital instructional material does not contain advertising or promotional material unless the:**

**(i) advertiser published the advertisement before 1990; and**

**(ii) advertisement is not sensitive material.**
