

Representative **Nicholeen P. Peck** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 133 through 143:*

133        (f) At the request of the state board, the Department of Health and Human Services shall  
134        provide recommendations to the state board as the state board develops the  
135        curriculum, rules, or programs described in this Subsection (2).  
136        (g) (i) {Each} Notwithstanding Subsection (3), an LEA shall include instruction in grades 3  
137        through 12 on human growth  
137        and development in regular classroom instruction at least once per year that includes, at a  
138        minimum, both of the following:  
139               (A) a high-definition ultrasound video, at least three minutes in duration, showing  
140        the development of the brain, heart, sex organs, and other vital organs in early  
140        fetal development; and  
141               (B) a video { showing} , at least three minutes in duration, that an organization offers  
142        online free of charge and that shows the process of fertilization and each stage of human  
143        development inside the uterus, noting significant markers in cell growth and  
143        organ development for every stage of pregnancy until birth.

2. *Line 144:*

144        (ii) Upon request, an LEA or school shall make available to the parent of a student

3. *Line 144 through 157:*

144        (ii) Upon request, an LEA or school shall make available to the parent of a student  
145        enrolled in the LEA or school any instructional materials the LEA or school uses  
146        in accordance with this Subsection (2)(g).

147        (iii) The state board shall {:

148        {A} publish a list of materials the state board deems appropriate for providing  
149        instruction under this Subsection (2)(g) on the state board's publicly accessible  
150        website {:

151        {B} at the beginning of each school year, conduct an audit of each LEA to verify  
152        {the LEA's compliance with this section; and}

153        {C} publish the findings of each audit no later than 120 days after the beginning of  
154        {the school year on the state board's publicly accessible website.}

**(iv) Each LEA shall provide an annual assurance to the state board that the LEA is in compliance with this Subsection (2)(g).**

155        (3) A student shall receive the instruction described in Subsection (2) on at least two  
156        occasions between the beginning of grade 7 and the end of grade 12.  
157        (4) (a) The state board shall, in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
