1. Line 9 through 15:

9 →defines terms;
10 →creates a minimum credit hour requirement rather than a day or instructional hour
11 requirement for certain grades in the public education system;
12 →requires driver education to be an attendance- {**verified**} **validated** program; and
13 →makes technical and conforming changes.
