Representative **Doug Welton** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 9 through 15:*

- 9 →defines terms;
- 10 →creates a minimum credit hour requirement rather than a day or instructional hour
- 11 requirement for certain grades in the public education system;
- 12 →requires driver education to be an attendance- { **verified** } **validated** program; and
- 13 →makes technical and conforming changes.

2. *Line 160 through 166:*

- 160 (ii) not associated with the school or under contract with the school under Subsection
- 161 53G-10-503(3); or
- 162 (f) any combination of Subsections (1)(a) through (e).
- 163 (2) A local education agency shall ensure that driver education **that the LEA provides** is an
- 164 attendance- { **verified** } **validated**
- 165 program, as defined in Section 53F-2-102.
- 166 [(2)](3) In accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the
- 166 state board shall establish in rule minimum standards for the school-related programs
