

**H.B. 597**  
**Alcohol Amendments**

Representative **Jefferson S. Burton** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 7 through 12:*

7 This Bill:

8 →provides that the Point of the Mountain State Land Authority is a local authority under  
9 Title 32B, Alcoholic Beverage Control Act;

→**provides that a driver license issued by a foreign country is a valid proof of age;**

10 →enacts provisions relating to the local consent of a local authority when the commission  
11 issues a license;

12 →amends provisions related to a designated conveyance area;

2. *Line 650 through 657:*

650 with federal law by the United States Department of State;

651 (iv) a military identification card that:

652 (A) includes date of birth; and

653 (B) has a picture affixed; ~~{-or}~~
