Representative **Raymond P. Ward** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 32 through 38:*

32 workforce availability, economic stability, and the ability of families to remain in the  
33 communities where they live and work;  
34 WHEREAS, the state contains many federally managed lands, some of which are classified  
35 as unreserved land, located within or immediately adjacent to existing municipal { or county }  
36 boundaries, including near established infrastructure such as roads, water, sewer, and power  
37 systems;  
38 WHEREAS, certain unreserved lands that lack a designated federal purpose may be

50 government for the purpose of facilitating moderate-income housing.  
51 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor urge that  
52 consideration be limited to unreserved lands located within or immediately adjacent to existing  
53 municipal { or county } boundaries or population centers within county boundaries, or in close  
proximity to existing infrastructure, where  
54 development can occur in a focused and efficient manner.  
55 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature and the Governor encourage the United  
56 States Congress to allow flexibility in the form of land exchanges or transfers, where
