

2nd Sub. S.B. 49
Natural Organic Reduction Amendments

Senator **Scott D. Sandall** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 793 through 809:*

793 on the private property of a consenting owner.

794 (4) If remains are to be disposed of on private property, other than dedicated cemetery
795 property:

796 (a) the authorizing agent shall:

(i) {-} provide the funeral service establishment with the written

797 consent of the property owner before disposal of the remains; and

(ii) notify the county recorder of the county in which the person disposes of the remains of the presence of remains on the property;

798 (b) the owner of the private property shall:

799 (i) ensure that the remains are placed on the private property within a removable
800 container;

801 (ii) place a physical marker directly adjacent to the removable container indicating
802 the placement of the remains; {-and}

803 (iii) before conveying the property on which the final disposition of the remains
804 occurs, {disclose to the person to whom the owner intends to convey the property:}

805 {(A) the existence of the remains on the property;}

806 {(B) the location of the remains on the property; and}

807 {(C) the day on which the remains were placed on the property.} **remove the remains from the private property; and**

(iv) after removing the remains from the private property, notify the county recorder described in Subsection (4)(a)(ii) that the remains are no longer on the private property; and

(c) a county recorder shall:

(i) after receiving notice of the placement of remains under Subsection (4)(a)(ii), indicate on the deed of the property that the property that contains remains; and

(ii) after receiving notice of the removal of remains under Subsection (4)(b)(iv), remove the indication on the deed of the property that the property contains remains.

808 (5) The knowing use of remains in growing food for human consumption is unlawful
809 conduct as described in Section 58-9-501.
