Senator **Lincoln Fillmore** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 37 through 42:*

- 37 (2) Except as provided in Subsection (3), a municipality or county may not:
38 (a) regulate the operation of an online marketplace; or
39 (b) require an online marketplace to provide the personal data of the online
40 marketplace's **website or digital platform** users without an administrative subpoena or court order.
41 (3) Subsection (2) does not limit or prohibit a municipality or county from:

 (d) enforcing Title 76, Utah Criminal Code; or
