Representative **Stephanie Gricius** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 55 through 61:*

- 55 (i) are not capable of living independently;
56 (ii) can live somewhat independently, with formal supports;
57 (iii) live independently; and
58 (iv) are a family member of a disabled individual; { ~~and~~ }
 (e) the number of individuals that the state protection and advocacy agency:
 (i) referred to and received voluntary treatment;
 (ii) petitioned for and were ordered into involuntary treatment;
 (iii) exited from homelessness into a residential or clinical setting;
 (iv) was able to advocate for assisted outpatient treatment or assertive community
treatment that resulted in placement or acquisition of supportive housing; and
 (v) advocated for with the goal of discontinuing any aspect of services or treatment deemed
to be appropriate for the need of the individual; and
