

Representative **Christine F. Watkins** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 8 through 13:*

8 →defines terms;

9 →repeals a study requirement for the Higher Education Appropriations Subcommittee that
10 this legislation fulfills;

→**requires the Higher Education Appropriations Subcommittee to ensure the inclusion of certain factors in non-statutory funding formulas for technical colleges;**

11 →establishes a process and formula for determining certain enrollment-based funding for
12 institutions of higher education, including degree-granting universities and technical
13 colleges;

2. *Line 71 through 81:*

71 report is due to the Higher Education Appropriations Subcommittee: the board's report
72 regarding each institution's strategic reinvestment plan described in Section 53H-8-210.

73 (3) In accordance with applicable provisions, the Higher Education Appropriations
74 Subcommittee shall {-} **:**

(a) complete the following:

75 **{(a)} (i)** an appropriation recommendation described in Section 53H-1-504 regarding
76 compliance with Subsections 53H-1-504(5) and (14); and

77 **{(b)} (ii)** as required by Section 53H-8-304, the review of performance funding described in
78 Section 53H-8-304 {·} **; and**

(b) ensure that all non-statutory performance and growth funding formulas that contribute to appropriations for technical colleges:

(i) include equivalent funding value for secondary and adult students; and

(ii) reflect the full responsibility of the technical college's statutorily-required services.
