Religious Curriculum in Schools

Senator **Todd Weiler** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Line 26 through 32:*

26 Section **53E-4-205.2**. is amended to read:

27 **53E-4-205.2** American constitutional government and citizenship course
28 standards.

29 (1) Beginning in the 2026-2027 school year, except as provided in Subsection (2)(e), and as
30 part of the social studies requirement

31 established under Section 53E-4-204, the state board shall require instruction on
32 American constitutional government and citizenship.
