LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends provisions related to mobile mammography insurance coverage.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- defines terms; and
- requires a health benefit plan to cover mobile mammography screenings in certain circumstances.

Utah Code Sections Affected:

ENACTS:

31A-22-630.1, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **31A-22-630.1** is enacted to read:

31A-22-630.1 . Mobile mammography screening coverage.

(1) As used in this section:

- (a) "Approved mobile mammography unit" means a mobile mammography bus or vehicle that is:
 - (i) equipped with mammography equipment to perform a mobile mammography screening; and
 - (ii) approved by an accrediting body designated by the federal Food and Drug Administration to perform mammography screenings.

- 29 (b) "Rural area" means a county of the third, fourth, fifth, or sixth class as classified
30 under Section 17-60-104.
- 31 (2) A health benefit plan that covers a mammography screening shall provide coverage of a
32 mobile mammography screening if the mobile mammography screening is performed:
33 (a) by an approved mobile mammography unit; and
34 (b) in a rural area.
- 35 (3) Coverage described in Subsection (2) shall reimburse the approved mobile
36 mammography unit at the same rate that a health benefit plan reimburses for an
37 in-network mammography screening performed in another setting.
- 38 (4) An approved mobile mammography unit:
39 (a) shall accept the amount reimbursed in Subsection (3) and any applicable enrollee
40 cost sharing as payment in full; and
41 (b) may only provide mammography screening services for an enrollee in accordance
42 with the United States Preventative Services Task Force Guidelines on age and
43 frequency.

44 Section 2. **Effective Date.**

45 This bill takes effect on January 1, 2027.
