375 Subsection 12(a). **Operating and Capital Budgets**

376 Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures Act, the
 377 Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or accounts indicated for
 378 the use and support of the government of the state of Utah.

379 ITEM 1 To Department of Health and Human Services - Clinical Services

380 From General Fund 19,000

381 Schedule of Programs:

382 State Laboratory 19,000

383 The Legislature intends that the Department of
 384 Health and Human Services use the appropriations in this
 385 item to fund the Rare Disease Advisory Council
 386 described in Section 26B-1-402.
