(1) Section 73-10-32.7, Study regarding water losses, is repealed July 1, 2027.

(2) Subsection 73-10g-607(5), regarding a requirement to report to an interim committee, is repealed January 1, 2027.

Section 3. Section **3** is enacted to read:

73-10-32.7. Study regarding water losses.

(1) As used in this section:

(a) "Division" means the Division of Water Resources.

(b) "Public water system" means the same as that term is defined in Section 19-4-102.

(2) The division shall, in conjunction with the Division of Drinking Water, conduct a study regarding water loss by public water systems under which the division shall:

(a) compile and analyze water loss estimates based on system size from data provided by a public water system for the period beginning January 1, 2015, and ending December 31, 2024;

(b) provide an overview of industry standard water loss principles and practices, including for both public system and end use water losses; and

(c) make recommendations on how to:
