### **General Description:**

This bill amends provisions related to insurance coverage.

19 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

20       Section 1. Section 1 is enacted to read:

21       **31A-22-663. Coverage for reversal of sex transition procedures.**

22       (1) As used in this section{, "sex transition procedure" means } :

23       (a) {hormonal-} "Hormonal transgender treatment" means the same as that term is defined in Section 58-1-603{;} :

23       (b) {a primary } "Primary sex characteristic surgical procedure" means the same as that term is defined in Section 58-67-102{; or} :

27       (c) "Secondary sex characteristic surgical procedure" means the same as that term is defined in Section 58-67-102.

29       (d) "Sex transition procedure" means:

30       (i) a primary sex characteristic surgical procedure; or

24       (c) (ii) a secondary sex characteristic surgical procedure {as defined in Section 58-67-102} .

32       (2) A health benefit plan that covers hormonal transgender treatments that the health benefit plan considers necessary for an individual's sex transition shall also cover any hormonal treatments necessary to reverse an individual's sex transition.

25       (2){(3)} A health benefit plan that covers {any} a sex transition procedure that the health benefit plan considers medically necessary shall also cover any {procedure, treatment, or therapy} surgical procedures necessary to reverse an individual's sex transition procedure.

27a       (4) { H→ {} {(3)} This section applies to a health benefit plan renewed or entered into on or after January 1, 2027.
