20 Section 1. Section 1 is enacted to read:

21 **31A-22-630.1. {Breast exam cost sharing} Mammography coverage.**

23 {(a) {"Cost-sharing requirement" means any copayment, coinsurance, deductible, or annual limitation
24 on out-of-pocket expenses required by a health benefit plan for a specific health care service
covered by the health benefit plan.}}

26 (a) "Approved mobile mammography unit" means a mobile mammography bus or vehicle that is:

27 (i) equipped with mammography equipment to perform a mobile mammography screening; and

(ii) approved by an accrediting body designated by the federal Food and Drug Administration to
perform mammography screenings.

(i){(b)} {"Breast examination"} "Rural area" means a {medical examination} county of the {breast
conducted by a health care professional} third, fourth, fifth, or sixth class as classified under Section
17-60-104.

(ii) {"Breast examination" includes:}

(2) A health benefit plan that covers a mammography screening shall provide coverage of a mobile
mammography screening if the mobile mammography screening is performed:

(a) by an approved mobile mammography unit; and

(b) in a rural area.

(3) Coverage described in Subsection (2) shall reimburse the approved mobile mammography unit
at the same rate that a health benefit plan reimburses for an in-network mammography screening
performed in another setting.

39 {(i) {when there is no prior indication that a breast health abnormality exists or is suspected;}-}
