32	(1) There is created a restricted account within the General Fund known as the "Corrections
33	Facility Expansion Restricted Account."
34	(2) The restricted account shall consist of:
35	(a) the portion of appropriations from new legislation for the Department of Corrections

37	(i) any state correctional capital facilities costs; and
38	(ii) one time savings that occur from delayed estimated fiscal impacts of increases in
