2 **LONG TITLE**

3 **General Description:**

4 This bill addresses selling or dispensing ivermectin without a prescription.

- 10 17b, Pharmacy Practice Act, to dispense and sell ivermectin:

  - 12 • without requiring consultation with a practitioner licensed to prescribe drugs or any
  - 13 other health care provider; and
  - 14 ▶ makes technical and conforming changes.

23 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

24 Section 1. Section **58-17b-508** is enacted to read:

25 **58-17b-508 . Ivermectin -- Dispensing or selling without a prescription --**

26 **Exclusion from unlawful or unprofessional conduct.**

27 (1) As used in this section, "ivermectin" means the prescription anti-parasitic drug approved  
28 by the United States Food and Drug Administration for use in humans.

29 (2) Notwithstanding Section 58-17b-501, Section 58-17b-502, or any other provision of

30       law, it is not unlawful or unprofessional conduct for a person licensed under this chapter  
31       to sell or dispense ivermectin:

32       (a) to a person who does not have a prescription; and

33       (b) without requiring consultation with a practitioner or any other health care provider.

34       **Section 2. Effective Date.**

35       This bill takes effect on May 6, 2026.
