Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53F-2-302** is amended to read:

21 53F-2-302 . Determination of weighted pupil units.

- (1) The number of weighted pupil units in the Minimum School Program for each year is the total of the units for each school district and, subject to Subsection (5), charter school, determined in accordance with this section.
- (2) The number of weighted pupil units is computed by adding the average daily membership of all pupils of the LEA attending schools, other than self-contained classes for children with a disability.
- (3)(a) Except as provided in Subsection (3)(b), for a fiscal year beginning on or after July 1, 2023, the number of weighted pupil units for kindergarten students shall be computed by adding the average daily membership of all pupils of the LEA enrolled

32	(b) The number of weighted pupil units is computed by multiplying the average daily
33	membership for the number of students who are enrolled in kindergarten for less than
34	the equivalent length of the schedule for grades 1 through 3, based on the October 1
