6 **LONG TITLE**

7 **General Description:**

8 This bill repeals Title 63G, Chapter 27, Public Contract Boycott Restrictions.

9 **Highlighted Provisions:**

10 This bill:

- 11 ▶ repeals provisions that prohibit a public entity from entering into a contract with a
- 12 company based on the company's participation in a boycott of the State of Israel or an
- 13 economic boycott;
- 14 ▶ repeals definitions and requirements related to boycott actions, economic boycotts, and
- 15 related contracting certifications;
- 16 ▶ repeals contract-certification, notice, and termination provisions applicable to public
- 17 entities and contractors; and
- 18 ▶ repeals provisions prohibiting interference with state programs or commercial
- 19 relationships related to boycott-based contracting restrictions.

29 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

30 Section 1. **Repealer.**

This bill repeals:

Section **63G-27-102, Definitions.**

31 Section **63G-27-201, Prohibition on contracting.**

32 Section **63G-27-202, Prohibition on interference with state programs and commercial**
33 **relationships.**

34 Section 2. **Effective Date.**

35 This bill takes effect on May 6, 2026.
