8 This rules resolution modifies the duties of a Senate standing committee.

10 This resolution:

11 ▶ defines terms;

12 ▶ when considering legislation that proposes to make an occupation a regulated occupation,  
13 requires a Senate standing committee to determine whether the Office of Professional  
14 Licensure Review conducted a sunrise review of the occupation; and

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**24 Be it resolved by the Senate of the state of Utah:**25 Section 1. **SR3-2-402** is amended to read:26 **SR3-2-402 . Standing committee consideration of legislation -- Regulated**  
27 **occupation -- Fiscal impact.****29 (1) As used in this rule:**30 (a) "Office" means the Office of Professional Licensure Review created in Utah Code  
31 Title 13, Chapter 1b, Office of Professional Licensure Review.32 (b) "Regulated occupation" means the same as that term is defined in Utah Code Section

33                   13-1b-101.

34                   (2) When considering legislation that proposes to make an occupation a regulated  
35                   occupation, a standing committee shall determine whether the office conducted a sunrise  
36                   review of the occupation in accordance with Utah Code Title 13, Chapter 1b, Part 3,  
37                   Office Review and Reporting.

38                   (3) Except as provided in SR3-2-401, a standing committee in one or both chambers  
39                   shall [review] consider legislation before the legislation is held in the opposite chamber  
40                   because of the legislation's fiscal impact.

41                   **Section 2. Effective Date.**

42                   This resolution takes effect upon a successful vote for final passage.
