3. Additional Study Items

On March 29, 2006 the LMC (Legislative Management Committee) met and divvied up the items from S.J.R. 10, Master Study Resolution, to the various interim committees for their consideration. 5. Special District Recodification - What Else Needs to be Done

A brief review of what has been done and what else needs to be done in the rewrite of Title 17A, Special Districts, will be presented. The Committee will consider how best to continue the rewrite. The Committee will consider whether to create a subcommittee or workgroup to continue the rewrite of Title 17A.

During the November 7, 2005 meeting of the Special Districts Subcommittee, the Utah Special Districts Association, bond counsel, and others committed to work together during the 2006 interim to standardize, where possible, special district bonding provisions. H.B. 44, Local Government Amendments, passed in the 2006 General Session, standardized some provisions but left other issues for discussion during the 2006 interim. A status report and plan for action will be discussed.

The 2005 Special Districts Subcommittee suggested the topic of standardizing special district taxing provisions be discussed during the 2006 interim. This topic will be introduced.

The rewrite has other uncompleted topics that will be identified.
