Automatic License Plate Readers

What information is stored?

- Picture of license plate
- Picture of front or rear of vehicle (cannot identify the driver)
- Date, time, and GPS location

Who has access to the database and for what purpose?

- Law enforcement personnel only
- For investigative purposes only

Where and how long is the information stored?

- The information collected is stored on a server that is located at the Capitol
- Information in the database is purged after one year

Why store the information for one year?

- Stolen vehicles
- AMBER alerts
- murder/homicide
- Homeland Security

Can personal information be accessed through the stored information?

- No. A search can only be done if the plate is known and does not include any information such as: name, date of birth, etc.
- Drivers license or DMV data would need to be accessed for that information.

In *United States v. Wilcox*, the court concluded that "Wilcox did not have a reasonable expectation of privacy in the plainly visible license plate and that the officers' use of the tag reader in this case did not violate the Fourth Amendment."
