

USOE evaluation shows higher performance mobile versus paper/pencil







4 percentage points more students on grade level, pilot vs paper/pencil

4 point improvement is a growth story


Year over Year Growth	% Students at Benchmark Spring 11-12	% Students at Benchmark Spring 12-13	Increase
Kindergarten	61	70	+9
First Grade	65	69	+4
Second Grade	66	70	+4
Third Grade	68	72	+4

Comparing participating students' benchmark status spring 11-12 to spring 12-13, n= ~43,200

Growth is driven by implementation fidelity



Implementation fidelity is high, with room to improve further



69% of Well Below Benchmark students were progress monitored with some fidelity; 43% with full fidelity from MOY-EOY in 2012-2013.

66% of Below Benchmark students were progress monitored with some fidelity; 48% with full fidelity.

High-fidelity districts achieve positive results
