



# Community Resource Center-

**Community Resource Center Budget Request–  
\$75,000**

Technology system & equipment	\$16,500.00	Wiring for entire building access for technology & phones, 5 computers for employment/tech center, tablet lab for child/youth education/social programs, access to wifi with server and appropriate fire walls and safety systems, on-line website and presence created
Central Office , common areas & Building Hallways	\$22,000.00	Carpet & flooring upgrades, paint, wall covers, doors and hardware in all shared space including waiting room, shared office, Multi-purpose room and hallways.
Exterior Improvements	\$15,500.00	Fencing installed, play area ground cover, outside equipment for pre-k programs & family activities – parking area improvements– replacement of windows for safety and safety regulations.
Security upgrades	\$6,500.00	security system, separation doors for programs, electric locks and entry ways, 2 monitor system, cameras, backdoor security, installed safety doors to pre-k and family areas
Program Equipment	\$10,000.00	Shelving, tables, chairs, equipment including pre-k learning center equipment and crisis nursery needs.
Electrical upgrades	\$4,500	Electrical clean up; upgrades and work to meet code with additional technology and communication needs met
MATCH	Minimum \$1 to \$1  Already Committed	Refurbishing of room by local companies, grounds work done in kind by volunteers, Air conditioning units and roofing work by community partners, Overhead of project implementation provided by Non-profits and County Government  Building Purchase at \$190,000; building upkeep for 1 year \$15,000; Staffing from partnerships once project is completed totals 10FTE staff from multiple organizations.
