ISSUE BRIEF

SUMMARY

In accordance with UCA 63J-1-504 requiring the agency to “submit its fee schedule . . . to the Legislature for its approval on an annual basis”, the following fees are proposed for the services of the Utah State Office of Rehabilitation Services. These fees will generate an estimated \$50,100 in FY 2015.

LEGISLATIVE ACTION

1. The Fiscal Analyst recommends the Subcommittee, after review and any adjustments, adopt the fee schedule referenced on page 1, Table 1. UCA 63J-1-504 states, “the Legislature may approve, increase or decrease and approve, or reject any fee submitted to it by a fee agency.”
