1. **6%**-The Road Home is a very efficient and professional organization that prides itself on getting the most from your generous donation. With an annual budget of \$14 million, only 6% is used for administrative and fundraising costs. The Road Home makes every dollar and donation count.
2. **4 Stars for 9 Years**- For nine consecutive years The Road Home has maintained the highest rating possible with Charity Navigator, America's premier independent charity evaluator. Charity Navigator evaluates the financial health, accountability and transparency of America's largest charities and in doing so gives The Road Home its highest rating, 4-Stars.
3. **7,219**- The Road Home serves at over 700 women, men, and families every day at our downtown year round shelter. During the winter months, we serve an average of 1,100 individuals in shelter each night. Last year the Road Home, through all our shelter programs, provided help and hope for a better future, to over 7,219 unduplicated individuals with 372,073 nights of shelter.
4. On any given night, we have approximately 800 individuals in shelter, including 200 children. This compares with approximately 1,350 individuals (including 525 children) in housing on any given night.
5. The Road Home's housing program is serving as a national model of excellence for proven success in ending homelessness.
6. We are increasingly effective in helping people overcome homelessness. We have helped more families than ever before. Our Rapid Rehousing Program for Families has an 87% success rate.
