- Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Interim Committee designated as "lead committee" by the Legislative Audit Subcommittee chaired by the Speaker and President

Report

- For each recommendation to the Legislature:
 - Draft legislation
 - Conclude that more time is needed to develop solutions
 - Conclude that there is insufficient committee support to study the issue further
- For other audit recommendations, determine whether appropriate action is being taken by agencies to address audit findings

Potential Committee Action

- Recommendations to the Legislature
 - Adopt policies that will require the phasing in of universal metering
 - Reduce water provider reliance on property taxes currently used to subsidize water system costs (Revenue and Taxation Interim Committee)
 - Require that water providers create reserve funds to cover the cost of infrastructure repair and replacement
 - Promote the use of conservation pricing structures
