NOTES:

- Industry definitions are from the US Bureau of Labor and Statistics and do not necessarily include all sectors of employment in Utah.
- The data is based on employment, one-year post graduation. A graduate is considered employed if a wage record was found at any-time during the specified year.
- Wage records were calculated from quarterly employer filings with the Unemployment Insurance database maintained by the Utah Department of Workforce Services. The Utah Employment Security Act requires Utah employers to submit wage quarterly wage information to the Utah Department of Workforce Services, including stocks, tips, in-kind, bonuses, etc.
- No adjustments or minimum requirements for earnings were applied.
- Does not include those employed in areas that do not participate in unemployment insurance reporting (e.g. Military, self-employed, stay-at-home,
