ISSUE BRIEF

SUMMARY

One outcome measure of higher education is the percentage of students who graduate from an institution within a certain time period. The standard looks at cohorts of first-time, full-time students and determines the percentage of that cohort who graduate within 150% of the degree period. For example, the measure counts first-time, full-time students who complete an associate’s degree within three years and those who complete a bachelor’s degree within six years.
