
UCAT STUDENT HEADCOUNT HISTORY

SUMMARY


This issue brief provides information on student headcount at UCAT colleges for high school (secondary) and adult students.

DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS


The following figures provide the student headcount from FY 2014 to FY 2016 for four distinct categories of students: certificate-seeking, continuing occupational education, other post-secondary, and secondary students. The first figure illustrates the total student headcount for each category across all the applied technology colleges. The remaining figures provide the student headcount for each student category by college. System-wide student headcount has fluctuated over time. Currently, student headcount is on the rise. In FY 2015 UCAT had a total of 36,193 students while in FY 2016 student headcount grew to 38,985. This growth was among all student categories except for other post-secondary students.




Bridgerland Applied Technology College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2016




Davis Applied Technology College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2016




Dixie Applied Technology College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2016




Mountainland Applied Technology College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2016




Ogden-Weber Applied Technology College, Student Headcount, FY 2014 - FY 2016
