

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Background

USDA Food & Nutrition Services provides the Child Nutrition Program (CNP) federal funding.

Child Nutrition Administers these programs:

- School Meals Programs
- Child and Adult Care Food Program
- Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program
- Special Milk Program
- Summer Food Service Program
- USDA Foods
- The Emergency Food Assistance Program



USDA Foods - Schools

Approximately **20%** of the foods used in schools are USDA Foods

USDA purchases commodities such as dairy and wheat from Utah farmers for school distribution

Utah sponsors will receive over \$18 million dollars in entitlement to obtain USA grown foods in state fiscal year 2017



The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

USDA Food Distribution Program provides administrative funding and food to foodbanks and food pantries

Utah Child Nutrition Programs provide oversight of funding, food ordering, delivery, and program compliance

USA grown foods valuing over \$3.5 million dollars were distributed to food banks and pantries in Utah in last year.
