BOTTOM LINE UP FRONT

- WHO: Utah National Guard
- WHAT: Requesting **\$8.4 million** for state share and utilities
 - \$4.4 critical this year for infrastructure
 - \$4 million necessary for construction in FY20
- WHERE: Nephi, Utah
- WHEN: Fiscal Year 18
- WHY: To qualify for FY2020 Military Construction (MILCON) funding




CURRENT SITUATION

- UTNG owns 30 acres in Nephi
- Property is adjacent to the Nephi Airport.
- Located within 2 miles of a Railhead.
- Strategic location for Domestic Response
- Utilities need to be brought to site (\$4.4 Million).
- 25% State Share of Building Cost (\$4 Million).
- If utilities and share not provided, State will lose \$12 Million Federal share for building.
- Nephi City donated property and providing GAS for project (\$600K)




GENERAL LOCATION

- This new Readiness Center will house the 1457th Engineer Brigade consisting of 178 Soldiers
- Operations are Monday thru Thursday and weekends.
- These units have over 80 pieces of equipment, vehicles, and trailers.
- This facility will replace 3 older facilities that do not meet the current and future needs of the Guard
