- I have found through my data collection in third grade this year that their preassessment scores and knowledge base of the SEL content area was greater than the prior year's preassessment scores. The data suggests that there was a 19.5% increase in correct answers (34.66% of preassessment questions answered correctly last year compared to 53.37% of preassessment questions answered correctly this year). One hypothesis is that this year's third grade had prior exposure to the SEL curriculum, assemblies and programs.


